The info below is to provide New racers an idea what safety items are required at given speeds. There are many simple rules not covered below.
(i.e.- a Master Battery Cutoff Switch is Mandatory when the Battery has been relocated, or as outlined in your class.)

14.00 & slower (8.60 & Slower*)

- Liquid Overflow -Tail Light - Auto Trans Reverse Lockout
- Pressurized Bottles (DOT 1800)

12.00 to 13.99 (7.50 to 8.59*)

- All items listed above plus - Driveshaft Loop (8.00 or faster with Street Tires)
- Helmet (Snell 85 or SFI 31-1 min) - Roll bar (convertibles only)
- Roll bar padding
- Driver Restraint System (SFI 16-1) & (Convertibles only)

11.99 to 11.00 (7.49 to 7.09*)

- All items listed above plus - Arm Restraints (Open Cars)
- Bell housing (SFI 6-1 / 6-2) - Driver Restraint System (SFI 16-1)
- Flywheel/Clutch (SFI 1-1 / 1-2) - Roll bar - Roll bar padding
- Protective Clothing

10.99 to 10.00 (7.08 to 6.50*)

- All items listed above plus - Aftermarket Rear Axles
- Harmonic Balancer (SFI 18-1) - Roll Cage
- Transmission Shield (SFI 4-1)

9.99 to 7.50 (6.49 to 4.77*)

- All items listed above plus -Auto Trans Flexplate (SFI 29-1)
- Flexplate Shield (SFI 30-1) - Master Electrical Cutoff
- Neck Collar - NHRA Competition License - NHRA Chassis Sticker
- Parachute (at 150mph & faster) - Window Net (Full Bodied Cars)

*** = 1/8th mile equivalent**

Data recorders (except for "playback" – type tachometers)
are prohibited in all E.T. classes.

Computers (except for OEM) are prohibited in all ET classes.
