

E.D.R.A. TRACK RULES

1 - UNSPORTSMANSHIP CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. Any verbal abuse to officials or staff will result in immediate removal from track.

2 - Drivers of ALL race vehicles must wear helmets. Drivers of vehicles running faster than 8.60 ET (1/8th mile) must wear helmets as required by NHRA Rules.

3 - Drivers must have proof of valid drivers license or NHRA license if required. All drivers under 18 must sign a Minor Participant form. Minors parent or guardian must sign minor Particapitant form.

4 - Drivers must wear sleeved shirts and long pants. No open-toed shoes allowed.

5 - Drivers must be wearing appropriate armband to race.

6 - No One under 14 years of age allowed in staging areas.

7 - Anyone entering the restricted areas, (e.g. staging lanes and track area) must have an armband.

8 - If someone other than original driver is going to make a pass in your car they must go to the tech inspector, show proof a valid license, and get an armband.

9 - No Standing burnouts. Rolling burnouts ONLY.

10 - Pit area and return road speed limit is 15 kmph.

11 - Lane choice determined by staging lanes director. (Numbered ball system)

12 - No burnouts, stunting, etc on any pit or return road area.

13 - All drivers of any motorized vehicle in the pits must have a valid drivers license.

14 - Race car and ONE tow/support vehicle allowed in pits.

15 - All Pit/Tow vehicles must be insured and numbered to corresponding race vehicle. Only one tow vehicle per race vehicle allowed in restricted areas.

16 - Dial-ins must be printed clearly on the driver's side door window and on right side of the windshield.

17 - Dial-ins may be changed between rounds.

18 - Dial-ins may not be changed on a re-run.

19 - Passengers allowed in race vehicles that run 8.14 ET (1/8th mile) and slower only. Passengers must wear the same helmet as required of the driver. Passengers under 18 must have signed parental release form. No passengers allowed during elimination rounds.

AREA. IN THE EVENT OF A LEAK OR SPILL, PLEASE FIND AN E.D.R.A. REPRESENTATIVE AND ASK FOR
SOME ABSORBALL TO CLEAN UP ANY SPILLS.

No glass bottles or containers are allowed at this event.

There is also no alcohol allowed at the Motor Sports Event.

Class Rules

A Limit of 80 Race Entries - Pre Registration Preferred.

Quick 16 (16 Quickest ET qualified)

A Event (64 race field) - B Event (! st round loser Buy Back)

All categories will run a (.500) Full Tree. (No electronics)

TOW VEHICLES: Children 14 years and under are to be inside the Cab or the car.

Truck tailgates are to be up with people inside and sitting down on the bed, not on the sides.

Please keep your speed down 15 kmph on the return road.

All entries will be allowed to change their dial-ins before each run. Bring your own shoe polish!

It is the Racers responsibility to display your dial-in on the Drivers side window, passengers side

Windshield and Rear window. Please write these numbers clearly and large to ease the timing

personnel to see Car numbers and Dial in's. Must be easy to read from the tower.

All complaints and/or questions should be referred to the personnel in the staging lanes or

E.D.R.A. tech personnel.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY RACERS BE ALLOWED IN THE TOWER.

All decisions on vehicle or bike safety inspections are final. - NO EXCEPTIONS.

If you break, Please pull over to the side of the track if possible.

This will help our safety crew clean up any spilled oils etc that could cause a hazard.

DO NOT STAY IN THE GROOVE ALL THE WAY TO THE END OF THE TRACK.

Racing is open to persons 16 and over who have a valid drivers license. Anyone under the age of

18 must sign a Minor's release form. The minor's parents or legal guardians must also sign the

minors release form. These forms are available at the track from the gate attendance and are good

for one race season.
